When to Use the ER

Go to the Emergency Room if you are having a medical emergency. You may need to call 9-1-1 if the person needs care fast where you are. Call your primary care doctor for **non-emergencies**. Or visit an urgent care center.



	After-Hours Care	Urgent Care	Emergency Room
How to Access Care:	Medical care provided after the regular practice schedule of your primary care physician.	Hours of operation are different for each center and may include evening and weekend hours.	Available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Located in many hospitals.
When to Use:	Your Doctor is not available and non-emergency care is needed.	Your Doctor is not available and non-emergency care is needed.	In an emergency, call 911 or go immediately to the nearest ER.
Your Time and Cost:	You will wait from 0 minutes to 15 minutes. It's much less costly than urgent or emergency care. Same copay as when you visit your primary care physician.	Usually less than an hour for non-emergency care. May have appointments or allow you to check in online. Costs are often lower than cost of an ER visit but higher than after hours clinic.	Care for most visits is provided within 3 hours, with more immediate care for emergencies. Costs are typically highest.
